I encourage you to keep connected to community so we can all help to support and remind you. If you are in a space where you feel like you can listen, that's great! We definitely need to learn from you about what you're hearing. I am looking forward to what God is planning to do among us in this coming year. The places God is planning to be active. I'm getting my listening ears ready. I hope you are too!

Thank You for Staff Christmas Gift






